**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION**

**Unless otherwise specified, all requirements listed below must be met by the filing deadline for application for admission to examination.**

Must meet all requirements of the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Law, including being a citizen of the United States.

Must not be less than eighteen (18) nor more than thirty-five (35) years of age.

Must have a high school diploma or a valid certificate of equivalency issued by a state department of education.

Before appointment, must pass a medical examination and a physical agility test designed to show good health and the physical abilities necessary to perform the duties of the position.

As a condition of the working test period, a probational Firefighter must attain and maintain EMT certification. (National certified) (Initial training for this requirement shall be included in on-the-job rookie firefighter training).

Must possess a valid driver's license.
