## **JOB ANNOUNCEMENT**

### ***Environmental Services Director***

Under the direction of the Mayor-President, this at-will position directs, manages, supervises, and coordinates all aspects of the East Baton Rouge Sewerage Commission (EBROSCO) and Sanitation Program. Work involves responsibility for the operation of the City-Parish Wastewater division including wastewater collection, conveyance, storage, and treatment systems, pretreatment and environmental programs, and laboratory services. Work also involves responsibility for the operation of the City-Parish Sanitation division including solid waste environmental functions, landfill management, and recycling programs. Duties include representation of the department in a variety of public forums (e.g. Metro Council meetings) and full management of the assigned services and related activities including financial and engineering planning, operation and maintenance, contract management, and customer service. Performs other work as requested.

#### **Qualifications:**

Section 5:04 of the Plan of Government: Shall (i) have received a college degree (which must include the completion of engineering courses, or business management courses, or public administration management courses) from an accredited four (4) year college or university, and (ii) have at least ten (10) years of relevant administrative/management experience.

Position may require possession of a license to practice professional engineering as issued by the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board. If license is required, must be maintained throughout employment in this position.

**Salary:**

\$81,404 - \$135,568 annually (depending on experience)

**Benefits:**

Defined benefit pension; car allowance or vehicle; deferred compensation; life, medical, and dental insurance; vacation and sick leave or paid time off.

**Baton Rouge Area:**

Baton Rouge, the State Capital, is located in Southeast Louisiana, 157 miles north of the Gulf of Mexico and 80 miles WNW of New Orleans via Interstate 10. Baton Rouge is also served by I-12, I-55, I-59, and I-49.

With a growing population of more than 400,000, East Baton Rouge Parish is Louisiana's most populous parish.

The City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge is managed by a single, consolidated form of government, with a Metropolitan Council as its governing body and the Mayor-President serving as its Chief Executive Officer.

Baton Rouge has a semi-tropical climate, perfect for outdoor activities; the weather is consistently warm from May to September; winter is usually mild and short-lived. Precipitation is reasonably well-distributed and ample throughout the year with an average annual precipitation of 55 inches.

As the Capital City of the State of Louisiana, the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Area boasts diverse cultural and recreational resources and activities, including numerous museums, dance, theatrical, musical companies, and a continuing series of festivals featuring free outdoor cultural and musical performances, indigenous to our region.

Baton Rouge is also home to two universities, Louisiana State University and Southern University, as well as Baton Rouge Community College.
