Marked Bike Facilities


- Yellow dashed line: On-Street Bike Lane

This map attempts to identify recommended bicyclist skill level for travel on each street. Streets were rated by members of the bicycling community that have a high skill level. The street category was determined by several factors including: traffic speed, traffic volume, outside lane width and the existence of shoulders or bike lanes.

Skill Level Definitions

Beginner
Beginner cyclists have limited riding experience or knowledge of the applicable traffic laws. Riders require more experience and training to ride in inclement weather conditions, difficult road conditions or higher speeds.

Intermediate
Intermediate cyclists have more experience riding and have a general understanding of the applicable traffic laws. In most cases, cyclists may ride in inclement weather conditions, difficult road conditions, or higher speeds.

Expert
Expert cyclists have significant experience riding and have a thorough understanding of the applicable traffic laws. Riders ride confidently in inclement weather conditions, difficult road conditions, or higher speeds.
